Wisconsin Council of the Blind is now accepting applications for loans. There are some criteria that must be met to be eligible for this funding.

Who is eligible?

- You must have good credit.
- You have income that would reasonably allow you to repay the loan.
- You must be a resident of Wisconsin.
- You must be legally blind or be a parent of a legally blind child purchasing adaptive equipment for that child.

What can the money be used for?

- To start a business or to improve an existing business, you may borrow up to \$50,000.
- There is a home improvement loan for up to \$10,000.
- The personal loan program allows you to borrow up to \$4,000.
- A technology loan allows you to borrow up to \$4,000 with a lower interest rate than the other loans.
