CONTEST DETAILS

1. Entrants **must** live or attend school in the Society's Assets service area of Racine, Kenosha, Walworth, Rock, or Jefferson counties.
2. Students in kindergarten through 12th grade are eligible.
3. Entries **must** be submitted on the 8 1/2+x 11+official ENTRY BLANK, or a copy of it. Both sides must be completed. Students in grades 9 - 12 **may choose** to submit their entries on a 22+X 28+sheet of paper with the 8 1/2+X 11+ **Official Entry Blank - - Back** (with the information section completed) attached to the back. Only artwork matching these two sizes will be considered by the judges.
4. Entries **must** include the theme words **Ability. . .Not Disability** as part of the artwork to meet judging criteria. **No other words (logos, brand names, labels, written descriptions, etc.) can be included.**
5. The poster must be created using a two-dimensional medium. More than one medium can be used, i.e. pencil and crayon, paint and marker, etc.
6. Computer-generated work is acceptable, but must be limited to less than 50 percent of the finished product.
7. Judges will review entries to ensure directions are followed and then to rate for uniqueness, composition, and portrayal of the theme words.
